

General Data Protection Regulations 2018

On 25th May 2018 new legislation comes into force; the General Data Protection Regulations 2018 or GDPR for short. GDPR introduces major changes as to how personal information is requested, used and stored by any organisation. These regulations also provide you, as an individual, with the right to see what personal information is held and request that any factual errors are corrected. Any information requested and held must be relevant and must not be passed to any third party without the subject's express permission.

In the case of MD Govier Electrical Engineering Ltd, we only ask for basic contact details and sometimes banking details for the purpose of payment. As a client of MD Govier you are agreeing to us using your contact details to allow us to send you messages and information regarding future works planning/commencing works/previous completed works, as well as contact you in an emergency.

We do not pass clients' personal information to any third party and it is used solely to allow us to operate as a business. All personal information of clients is held and managed by the Directors. The Director fulfils the role of Information Officer and will be responsible for the security of all personal information held by the Company. No other member of staff will have access to this information, unless they have been given the role of project manager, which requires communication with the client.

MD Govier Electrical Engineering Ltd believes that our current procedures for information management are compliant with GDPR.
